ACADEMIC STANDINGS

The student is in Good Academic Standing unless otherwise noted. Academic Suspension is for two semesters. After two semesters a student may apply for readmission. Academic Dismissal is permanent.

ACADEMIC HONORS

If the student completes 12 or more credits in one 16-week semester or phase at Cochise College and maintains a semester GPA of 3.9 or better, the student is recognized as achieving high academic honors – President's List. If the student completes 12 or more credits in one 16-week semester or phase at Cochise College and maintains a semester GPA of 3.5 to 3.89, the student will be recognized as achieving academic honors – Dean's List.

Courses that have the designation of "With Honors," "HON" subject prefix or an "H" following the course number indicate the classes are of the highest rigor.

MILITARY CREDENTIALING PROGRAM (MOS)/ NON-TRADITIONAL TERM

Certain Military and Department of Defense (DOD) students may have earned credits during fulltime military training that is taught by Cochise College Adjunct Faculty in a classroom environment. Credit from military transcripts (JST, AARTS, SMART, CCAF, or CGI) may be similar.

MOS students may receive up to 64 credits. Credits are awarded as semester hours in non-traditional terms. These students attend classes 40 hours a week for periods up to one year. Beginning July 1, 2016, a non-traditional term was created for MOS students.

TRANSFER CREDIT

Credits earned at other institutions and accepted by Cochise College are recorded in semester hours.

DISCIPLINARY REMARKS

The Cochise College transcript includes disciplinary remarks in situations where students have been long-term suspended or expelled.

GRADING SYSTEM

The grading system provides a range of grade levels indicating the student's achievement of the objectives established for a course. Grade definitions are as follows:

- A – 4.0 Pts. = Superior achievement of the educational objectives.
- B – 3.0 Pts. = Good achievement of the educational objectives.
- C – 2.0 Pts. = Average achievement of the educational objectives.
- D – 1.0 Pts. = Poor achievement of the educational objectives.
- F – 0.0 Pts. = Failure, unsatisfactory achievement.
- W – 0.0 Pts. = Withdrawal without academic assessment.
- WF – 0.0 Pts. = Computed in the student's GPA as an "F", or failure.
- G – 0.0 Pts. = A General Enrichment grade is not computed in the student's GPA.
- I – 0.0 Pts. = Incomplete is not computed in the student's GPA.
- IW – 0.0 Pts. = Incomplete is not computed in the student's GPA.
- AU – 0.0 Pts. = Audit is not computed in the student's GPA.
- P – 0.0 Pts. = "Passed" is not computed in the student's GPA, and is considered a "C" or better.
- X – 0.0 Pts. = Failure in a pass-fail course. No credit awarded. It is not computed in the student's GPA.
- XF – 0.0 Pts. = Failure in a pass-fail course. No credit awarded. It is not computed in the student's GPA.
- DUP – 0.0 Pts. = Duplicated course.
- In Progress = Indicates that the course has not been completed and final grades have not been recorded.
- NGR – 0.0 Pts. = Used for transfer work from other institutions. It is not computed in the student's GPA.
- TA/B/C 0.0 Pts = Used for transfer work from other institutions. It is not computed in the student's GPA.

COURSE REPEATS

- R – 0.0 Pts. = Course repeated. All units and honor points removed from cumulative GPA.
- E – 0.0 Pts. = Course excluded. All units and honor points removed from GPA. Policy became effective Fall 1983.
- I – 0.0 Pts. = Course repeated. All units and honor points included in GPA. Policy became effective Fall 1983.
