Notes:

- ECE 150 and EDU 201 are usually offered in both the fall and the spring semesters and are 16-week classes
- EDU 222 is only offered in 16-week semesters
- All other ECE classes are typically only offered once during the academic year in an eight-week semester aligned with what is noted above.
- Recommend students are employed in an early childhood care or education facility OR enrolled in EDU 224 Field Experience in Education.
- Students must complete one of the three Core Curriculum Classes: ECE 155, ECE 156, or ECE 165.
- Six (6) credits must be in Intensive Writing.
- MAT 142 is the recommended prerequisite for MAT 154 and MAT 156
- MAT 154 and MAT 156 may be taken in any order.
- Recommended for the Gen Ed-Arts: ART 120 Appreciation of the Visual Arts OR MUS 260 Music Fundamentals through Experience
