2. PUBLIC HEARING

2.01 Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Proposed Budget, Including Approval of the FY 2025-2026 Workforce Development (Proposition 301) Plan

Mr. Hudgins stated pursuant to A.R.S. §15-1461, the Governing Board shall hold a public hearing and present the proposed budget to people attending the hearing. Upon request of any person, the Governing Board shall explain the budget and any resident or taxpayer of the district may protest the inclusion of any item in the proposed budget.

Dr. Perey stated pursuant to A.R.S. §15-1461, the budget was duly published in the Sierra Vista Herald, the paper of record on May 25, 2025, and on June 4, 2025. The budget schedules A, B, and C were shared with the board.

Schedule A highlighted the total funds and estimated personal compensation at \$40,998,091 and the tax levy rate placed by the board in the amount of \$28,424,248.

Schedule B highlights the general fund for 2026 amounting to \$57,547,584. Restricted funds started with \$8,517,923 in addition to funds from Prop 207 and Rural Aid.

For 2026, the total budget is \$94,222,699, a decrease of 3.6% from last year's budget. The budget is based on the college's mission and priorities and follows budget principles. Additionally, the budget allows for contingencies and is balanced.

Mr. Hudgins opened the public hearing. Seeing and hearing no requests to speak, Mr. Hudgins adjourned the meeting.
