Position Title: Executive Assistant – Academic Services

Position Summary: The Executive Assistant – Academic Services is responsible for performing a full range of administrative support work to the Executive Vice President for Academics and other faculty and staff requiring the application of specialized technical and administrative knowledge and the exercise of initiative, independent judgment, and decision making.

Essential Functions: As defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act, may include any of the following tasks, knowledge, skills, and other characteristics. This list is ILLUSTRATIVE ONLY, and is not a comprehensive listing of all functions and tasks performed by incumbents of this class.

Duties and Responsibilities: Within the scope of college policies and procedures, this position:

Provides comprehensive support to the Executive Vice President; prepares, receives and distributes letters, memoranda and other correspondence; maintains department files, maintains appointment calendars, prepares process checklists and flow charts

Schedules and maintains appointments, calendars and contacts for Executive Vice President; prepares, edits, and enhances correspondence on behalf of the Executive Vice President

Serves as the first responder to inquiries; assists department staff by addressing questions related to college processes and/or identifies specialist in specific areas; assists employees in understanding established policies and procedures

Maintains department fiscal records, including processing of purchase and travel requisitions, purchase orders, invoices, travel vouchers, etc. and reconciliation of budgets; investigates vendor issues as needed; reconciles and files pcard transactions for Executive Vice President

Serves as a recorder for select committees, communicates with committee members, takes minutes, reserves rooms, and maintains committee portal documents

Assists in maintaining department web pages on the college web site; maintains electronic forms for a variety of college academic functions

Performs other related duties as assigned

General Expectations: Employees are expected to accomplish assigned duties in an efficient, effective and competent manner and to strive for improvement and excellence in all work performed. Additionally, employees must understand the comprehensive role of the community college and cooperate and work harmoniously with students, faculty and staff, and the public. Employees will follow all college policies, rules, regulations and guidelines as they relate to this position.

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Education and Experience Requirements:

Associate's degree from an institution accredited by an institutional accrediting body of higher learning recognized by the US Department of Education

Five years progressively responsible experience in an office management environment

Preference may be given to individuals who are bilingual in English and Spanish

An equivalent combination of education and/or experience from which comparable knowledge, skills and abilities have been achieved may be considered.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Knowledge of and ability to follow college policies and procedures

Knowledge of current technologies and word processing, database, presentation, and spreadsheet software, specifically Microsoft Office applications and Banner

Knowledge of the general proper operation of and the ability to use personal computers and standard office equipment

Ability to communicate effectively, verbally and in writing, and to relate to others in a professional, helpful manner

Ability to relate to a diverse population and to maintain composure when faced with difficult situations

Ability to organize, prioritize, and follow multiple tasks through to completion with an attention to detail

Ability to work independently while contributing to team environment

Ability to analyze problems, identify solutions and take appropriate action, resolve problems using independent judgment and decision-making processes

Ability to operate standard office equipment

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with supervisors, other department staff, students and the public

Ability to work accurately, efficiently, and effectively with all types of data

Ability to maintain accurate office procedures

Ability to work under pressure with frequent interruptions

Ability to supervise and monitor the work of others

Work Environment: Work is primarily performed under general supervision. Incumbent generally performs work in a typical office setting with appropriate climate controls.

Physical Requirements: Essential functions of this position require: lifting, manual dexterity, ability to communicate.

Sedentary Work: Exerting up to 10 pounds of force occasionally and/or a negligible amount of force frequently or constantly to lift, carry, push, pull or otherwise move objects, including the human body; involves sitting majority of time; walking and standing are required only occasionally and all other sedentary criteria are met

Mental Application: Utilizes memory for details, verbal instructions, emotional stability, critical thinking, adaptability and creative problem-solving skills are important
