Policy Number: 201
Title: Board Responsibility**

The District Board is a collective body that represents the community in determining and assuring appropriate organizational actions and performance. Specifically, the District Board:

- a. Serves as the official governance link between Cochise College and the community.
- b. Employs and supervises the College President.
- c. Directs the College through the establishment of policies.
- d. Monitors College performance.
- e. Evaluates the College President through a formal annual review.
- f. Monitors its own performance at monthly meetings.
- g. Evaluates its own performance, annually.
- h. Serves as an advocate for Cochise College.

The performance of the Board rests upon individual Board members exercising responsibility in such areas as: College events, Board meetings and Board-development activities, state and national Board meetings, and in representing the community to the College. Board performance also depends upon the knowledge of Board members relevant to College operations, in such areas as: College strategic plans, annual budgets, and state statutes.
