Title: Academic Status**

The vice president for instruction/provost shall develop procedures to determine the academic status of students.

**Procedure 3008.1
Good Standing, Probation, Suspension**

Good Standing: A student is considered to be in good standing as long as the Cochise College cumulative grade point average (GPA) is 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

Probation: Once a student has attempted 13 or more credits, the student's academic status is reviewed after each semester. If the Cochise College cumulative grade point average (GPA) is below a 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale), the student will be notified that s/he has been placed on academic probation and a notation of the academic status will be placed on the transcript. While on probation, the student will be permitted to enroll in 12 or fewer units for the semester.

Suspension: If a student's Cochise College cumulative GPA falls below 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale) for two consecutive terms, the student will be suspended from school and a notation of the academic status will be placed on the transcript. *Note: If a student is suspended following the spring semester, the student may not attend classes the following summer and fall semesters. If a student is suspended following the fall semester, the student may not attend classes the following spring and summer semesters.*

Academic standing will be calculated at the end of fall and spring terms only.
