GENERAL ADVISING NOTES

ENG 101 is a prerequisite for ENG 102.

Students are encouraged to take BUS 104, MAT 132 or higher in their first semester to allow time for completion.

Completion of BUS 104 or MAT 132 or higher required before taking CUL 204.

CUL 107 can be taken concurrently with CUL 215, CUL 217, and CUL 220. CUL 220 is a prerequisite for CUL 221. CUL 215 is a prerequisite for CUL 225. CUL 225 is a prerequisite for CUL 226. CUL 226 is a prerequisite for CUL 275. CUL 217 and CUL 275 are prerequisites for CUL 280. CUL 280 is a prerequisite for CUL 281. CUL 107 is a prerequisite for CUL 224. CUL 224 – Field Experience in Culinary Arts requires at least 1 credit and up to 4 can be completed. Culinary program offered as a Day program (Fall start) and Night Program (Spring start). Refer to the Cochise College General Education (GE) lists for options in Liberal Arts. You may locate course descriptions at www.cochise.edu/catalog Placement testing required for Math, English, and Reading. Students placing into developmental courses will need to complete these in the first semester(s). Developmental courses do not count in the degree.
